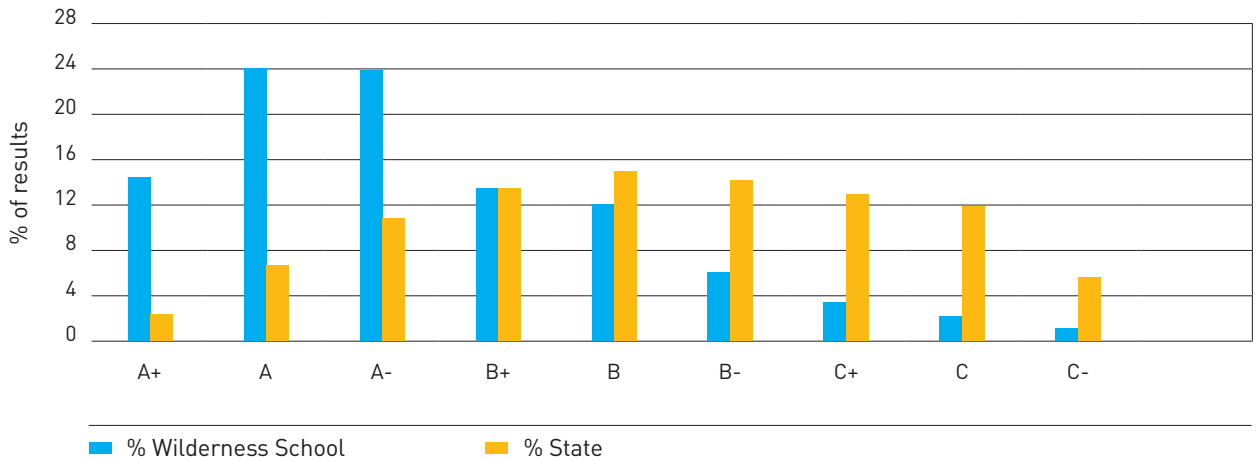

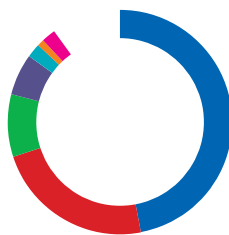
Of the cohort, 60% were placed in the top 10% of Year 12 students, with 41% in the top 5% and 19% in the top 1%.
